Outdoor Shooting Range: The outdoor range has been cleaned up and repaired again. It was sad to see the 6x6's that were used to hold up targets totally destroyed and garbage that was brought in, to use as targets left lying around. OUTDOOR RANGE RULES

1. All shooters must register at the clubhouse
Before shooting.
2. Warning flags must be in place before shooting.
3. All shooting must take place from designated
Shooting stations.
4. Discharge of weapons in a rapid-fire sequence is prohibited.
5. No placing targets against target-holding
structures (i.e. posts, etc.)
6. Please clean up after you are done

NOTE: One Guest in the company of a member and they must be registered before shooting.

3-F Club Hunting Rules:

No permanent tree stands

All stand hunters are required to wear safety harness

All stands should be marked with membership number so they can be seen from the ground

No stands hung before September 1st

All stands should be removed by January 1st; if stands are still up they will be removed and become club property.

No deer drives of any kind

These rules aren't to discourage any member from hunting the property; they are intended to keep non-members from using the club we all pay for. It has been brought to our attention that in the past non-members have hunted the property, by marking your stands and removing them by the required date will help us identify the stands that do not belong on the property.

Spring goose season will be closed on the club. There has been a lot of time and effort to get geese to return and mate during this time period. The fall season will be open to all members.
